## GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. Gate entry prices:- Adults \$5:00; Children under 16 free.
2. Horse sections commence at 8:15 am.
3. All other stock to be on the grounds by 9 30 am.
4. All produce, machinery and stalls to be staged by 9 30 am.
5. Produce Shed exhibits staged by 10 am sharp.
6. No stock, produce, machinery or stalls to be removed from the grounds before 4 pm. unless prior permission has been granted by the Secretary or the Head Marshall of Section concerned.
7. PARADE OF PRIZE STOCK will be held after the Machinery Parade. All prize winners in the Horse Section MUST PARADE. Cattle Section optional.
8. Only Ribbons won on the day of the Show are to be displayed.
9. ENTRIES: must be accompanied by total fees and be in the hands of the Secretary on or before the closing dates in the schedule. A pass ticket will be given at time of entry for all entries over \$6.
10. All entries received by telephone/fax must be confirmed by the first available post.
11. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
12. All stock must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor or family living at home and (other than prime stock) must have been in his/her possession at least one month before date of Show. Prime stock – three months.
13. Exhibitors will be required to state as accurately as possible the known age of all stock where age is specified.
14. District Exhibitors must reside in the district between the Rakaia and Waimakariri Rivers, and, west of the Main South, Dawsons and Chattertons Roads.
15. PRIZES: In all cases where two or more Prizes have been awarded, the Judges are directed to commend or highly commend the other exhibits worthy of distinction.
16. No third prize money will be paid in any class unless there are five or more entries.
17. In all cases where the Judges consider there is want of merit in any particular class, they shall be empowered to award Second prize only in lieu of First.
18. The Committee reserves the right to substitute Trophies and/or vouchers in lieu of cash prizes, should offers come to hand after issuing the Schedule.
19. In the case of unforeseen circumstances preventing the revenue amounting to the expected sum, prizes will be paid in proportion to the revenue received.
20. All prizes not claimed by the 31<sup>st</sup> January next, shall be forfeited.
21. POINTS for Trophies count as follows: First prize : 3 points  
Second prize: 2 points  
Third prize: 1 point
23. In the event of a tie for a Trophy or Cup, the winner of the largest number of firsts shall have preference and if still a tie, Seconds then, shall take preference and so forth.

- 24 Competitors are expected to observe good manners, etiquette and sportsmanship at all times. Inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated from any competitor, exhibitor or spectator whom may be subject to disciplinary action by the Committee.
- 25 PROTESTS must be delivered to the Secretary in writing accompanied by a fee of \$20 within an hour of the exhibits being judged and awards distributed. The decision of the Protest Committee shall be final. The fee will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained.
- 26 The Committee will not, under any circumstances, hold themselves responsible for loss, damage or mis-delivery of stock, produce or machinery exhibited at the Show.
28. DOGS must be under control and leashed at all times unless participating in an authorised event.
29. Any Exhibitor infringing any of the above regulations shall be subject to be dealt with as may be decided by the Committee, whose decision shall be final.

## **HORSES**

**Judging commences at 8.15am**

Measuring will commence at 7.15am until 8.15am.

### **CONDITIONS:**

- **DRUG TESTING** - Any Horse or Pony which, in the opinion of the Drug Testing Steward, D. McConchie, has been given any tranquiliser, stimulant, or any drug which would affect its performance will be disqualified. Random testing for forbidden substances will be carried under the conditions adopted by the Equestrian Federation of N.Z.. Your signature on the entry form denotes acceptance of these conditions.
- The Committee reserves the right to object to and /or remove from the grounds any person being heavy handed or harsh to a horse or pony.
- The members in attendance may remove any horse or pony from the ring, if in their opinion, it is a danger to other competitors.
- No prizes to be awarded if the Judge considers the horse unsound.
- Judges are directed to award prizes only to animals, which they consider free from hereditary unsoundness.
- **Judges' decision shall be final**
- Stallions are permitted in Hunter Jumping and to be identified by "S" on either side of bridle. All other classes to be mare or gelding unless otherwise specified.
- Names of horses to be given.
- In stating age of horse the year to count from 1st August.
- All riders to be under the age stipulated on day of show.
- In all classes where height is specified 5mm will be allowed for shoes, and competitors must carry height certificates.
- Certificates of Height - Life, Annual, Ashburton, Northern and Canterbury A&P's will be accepted.
- Refunds : 75% refund upon production of a medical or veterinary certificate. Substitutions may be accepted – contact secretary.
- Registered partnerships and leases are acceptable but proof may be required.
- All Hackneys, Non Hackneys and Miniature Horses in harness are invited to parade just prior to the Machinery Parade.
- All horses/ponies must be haltered and led.

### **DEFINITION OF A MAIDEN**

- A horse or pony that has not won a First Prize in an adult confirmation class at closing date of entries, at an A. & P. Show.
- All Maiden ponies to be shown in **snaffle** bits in all classes.
- Horse or pony that has won a District Maiden class is eligible for Open Maiden Classes and/or Novice Classes.

### **DEFINITION OF NOVICE**

- A Novice horse or pony, is one that has yet to win six classes in any division within the competitions (eg. Conformation class, Paced & Mannered) provided at any A & P Show. Upon achieving the sixth win in a division, a horse or pony thereafter must compete in the appropriate open classes within that division.
- Novice wins to be counted at time of show.
- If Horse/Pony is upgraded, entry to another class is permitted or entry fee can be reclaimed. Inquires to Secretary.
- Novice Horse & Ponies to be shown in **snaffle bits** only.
- Novice may enter open classes.
- As District Classes are restricted they do not count as Novice wins.

#### **DISTRICT**

- Exhibitor and Rider must reside in the district, between the Rakaia and Waimakariri Rivers, and west of the Main South, Dawsons and Chattertons Roads.
- Consideration cannot be given to riders where judging times in different groups conflict.
- Competitors may be disqualified if not ready when called.

#### **ENTRY FEES – Members \$4.00, Non Members \$6.00**

- (exception class 372 – Members \$6.00 Non Members \$8.00)

**Fees include Royal Agricultural Society Levy of -50 cents per entry**

#### **PRIZES in all Sections - First \$10, Second \$7, Third \$5**

(with exception of class 372 : First \$60, Second \$30, Third \$15)

Prize Money in all Horse Sections will be paid on day of Show.

No third prize money unless 5 or more entries.

#### **BACK NUMBERS - Courtenay A & P Association numbers to be worn by riders/handlers – Breastplate numbers are not permitted.**

A deposit for Back Numbers of \$3 per Horse or Pony is to be paid with Entry Fees.

#### **THE E.E. JENKINS MEMORIAL CHALLENGE CUP**

is awarded for most points in all Horse Sections
